DAY 6: KAHULUI, MAUI

Arrive in Maui for a round at the island's only private club.

EXCLUSIVE: King Kamehameha Golf Club

Named after the greatest King in Hawaiian Island history, this course will challenge you to use every club in your bag. The King Kamehameha Golf Club follows Robinson's philosophy: the golfer attacks, the designer defends. Best yet, sitting at 750 feet above sea level, it offers spectacular views of the island's glittering coasts and Haleakala volcano.

Non-golfers will enjoy an all day **Hana excursion** through rainforests and waterfalls. Highlights include Keanae Peninsula, Waterfalls, Waianapanapa State Park, Wailua Overlook, Haleakala National Park, Hana Town & Bay and Hana Flower Gardens. (Lunch included).

The South Course snakes through the stark, rugged a'a lava of the prehistoric Kaniku lava flow, offering a panorama of mountain and ocean views alongside the challenging golf experience. It is home to #15, one of the world's most photographed over-the-ocean golf course holes. Take your time here and savour the experience that is unlike any other.

Non-golfers enjoy a day at leisure to explore **Kona**. Just across from the tender pier is the King Kamehameha Hotel, a historic Hawaiian temple and a small beach. Wander through the town for quaint shops and cafes, you'll even find a seaside **Bubba Gump!**
